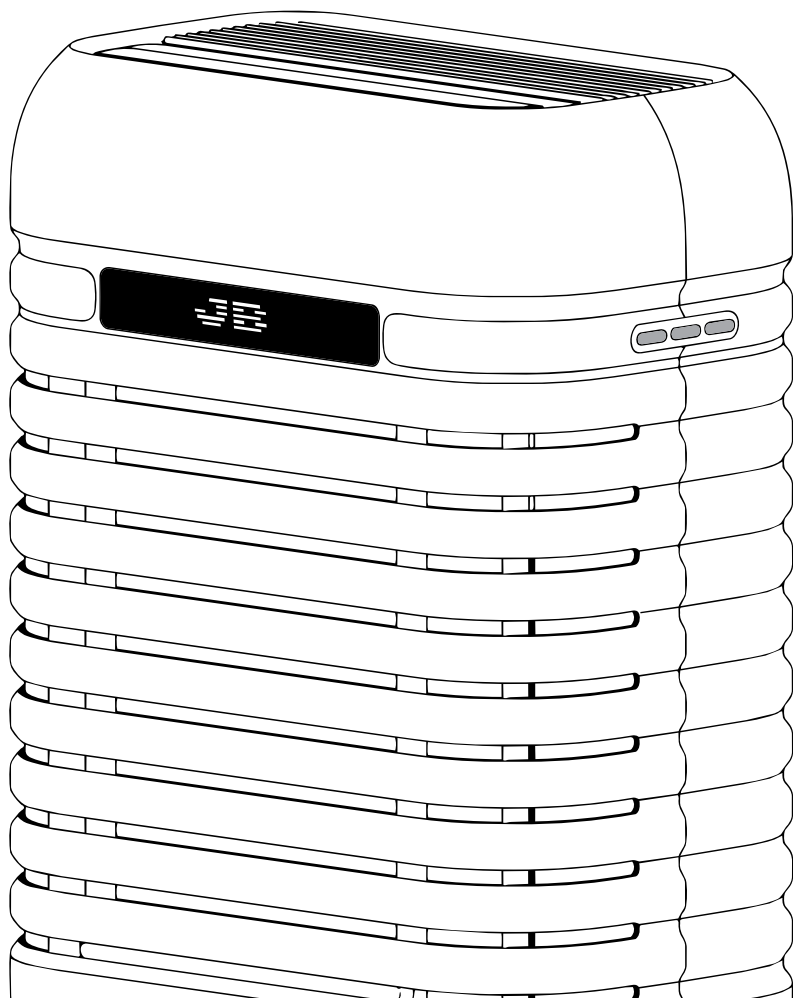

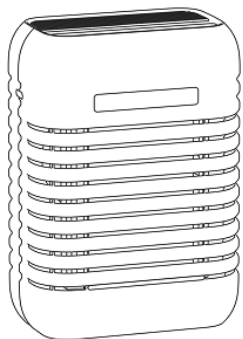

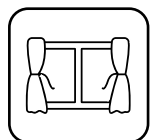
01 JB Air purifier

For the best performance



Close all windows and doors during operation.



Avoid placing your air purifier behind furniture, curtains, or in corners.



Turn on a ceiling fan to help cycle the air.



Do not place objects over the air outlet or vents.

⚠ Before first use

- ✓ Keep space around AIR for uninterrupted airflow.
- ✓ Remove all protective layers.
- ✓ Place AIR on a flat surface.
- ✓ Indoor use only

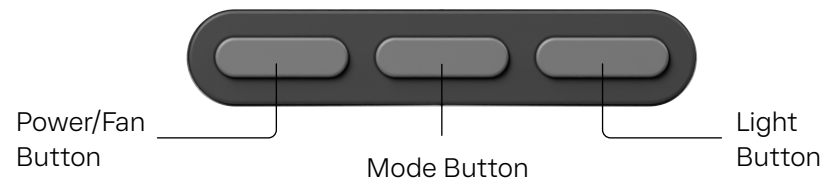

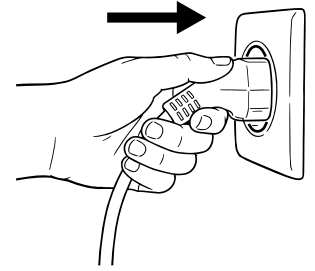

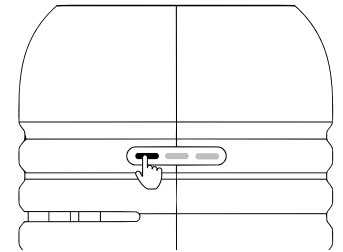

Connect AIR to a wall socket.



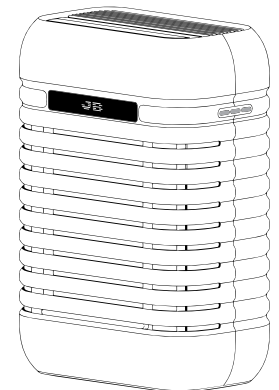

Press and hold the Mode button for 3 seconds to enter pairing mode and follow in-app instructions to complete pairing.

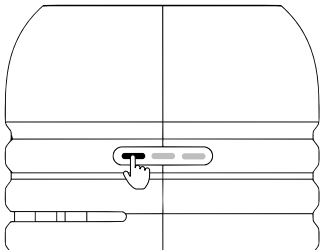

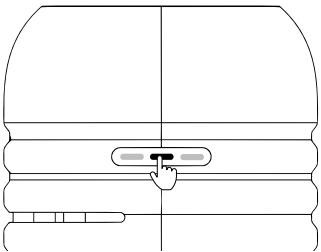
Adjust Fan Speed



Fan Speed
Includes three fan speed settings:
Low, Medium, and High.

Press the power/fan button once to cycle fan speed.

Change Modes



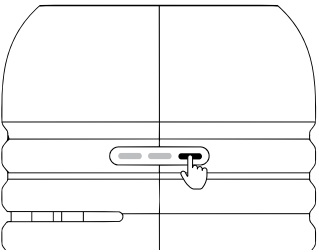
Auto Mode
Auto Mode adjusts fan speed automatically based on real-time air quality.

Sleep Mode
Sleep Mode reduces fan speed and lighting for quieter nighttime operation.

Press the mode button once to switch between modes.



Control Lighting

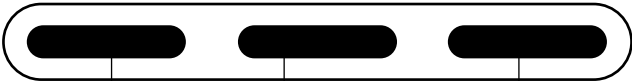


AQI Light
Displays surrounding air quality in real time.

Night Light
Soft lighting designed for low-light environments.

Light Off
Turns off all lighting for distraction-free operation.

Press the light button to switch lighting modes.



Power/Fan Button
One Time Press
Fan speed: 1, 2, and 3
Press and hold
Turn device ON/OFF

Mode Button
Normal Press
Change mode: Sleep and Auto
Hold press
Trigger pairing state

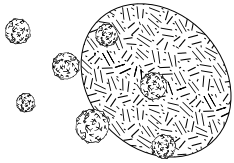
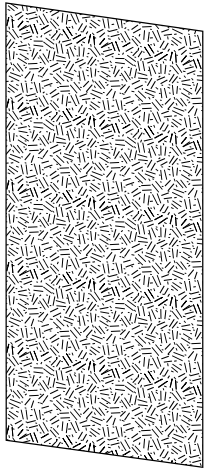

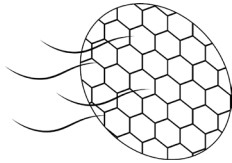
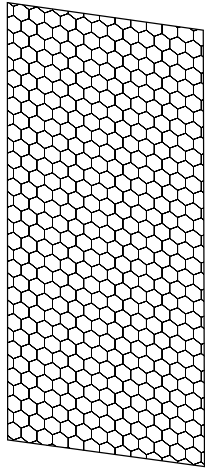
How your purifier works

Multi-Stage Filtration

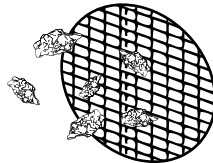
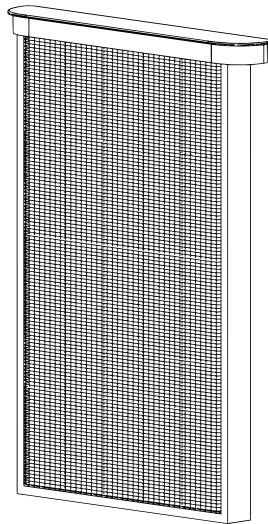
The purifier pulls room air through a multi-stage filter.



The pre-filter helps catch large particles.



The activated carbon layer helps decrease odors.



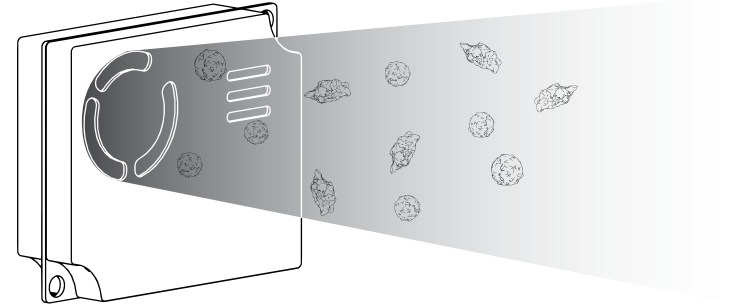
The HEPA 13 filter catches fine airborne particles.

Following the 3-stage filtration process, purified air is dispersed into the room.



Laser Particle Sensor

The built-in laser particle sensor estimates indoor air quality. The sensor detects fine particles such as PM2.5 and PM10.



In Auto mode, the purifier adjusts operation when air conditions change.

Air-quality readings can change quickly.

This can occur because of:

- Dust
- Smoke
- Incense
- Cooking fumes
- Aerosol sprays
- The position of the purifier
- Cleaning activity
- Open windows
- Humidity



Use the readings as a guide for daily indoor air quality. The readings are not laboratory measurements.



Filter Care

Replacing the filter

The device and app send a warning for a filter change.

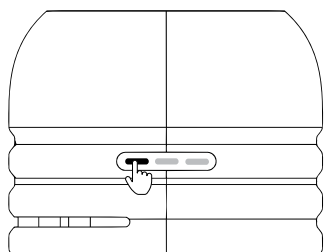
The screen on the device displays the following:

⚠ Also replace the filter if:

- Odor reduction becomes poor.
- The filter is heavily clogged.
- The filter is damaged.
- The filter is moldy.
- The filter is wet.
- The filter is oily.
- Airflow stays weak after you clean the pre-filter.

Use genuine JB replacement filters for best performance.

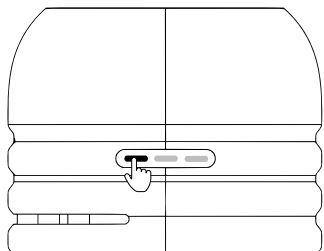


Cleaning the Filter

Clean the pre-filter regularly, this helps keep airflow stable.

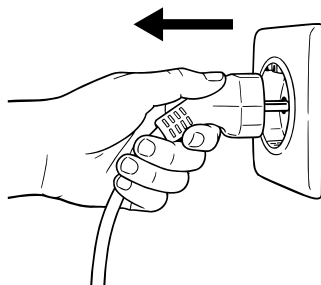

Switch off the purifier.



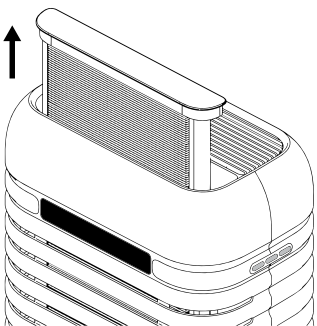

Unplug the purifier.



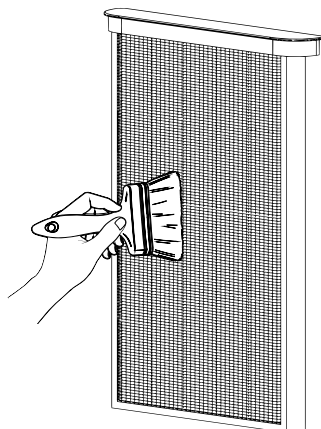

Slide out the filter assembly.



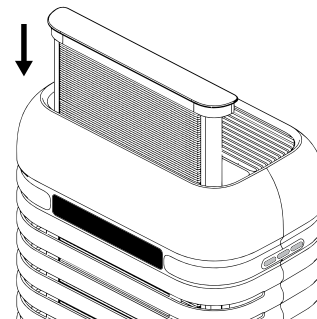

Clean visible dust from the pre-filter. Use a dry cloth, dry brush, or vacuum cleaner on low suction.



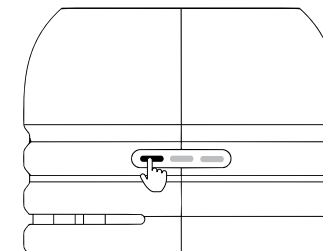

⚠ If you do not use the purifier for a long time

- Switch off the purifier.
- Unplug the purifier.
- Clean visible dust from the outer body.
- Clean visible dust from the pre-filter.
- Keep the filter dry.
- Store the purifier indoors.

Important Care Instructions

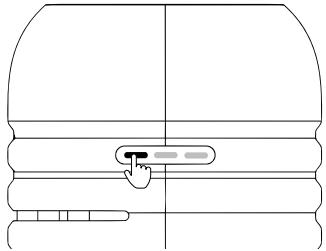
- ⚠ Do not wash the HEPA 13 filter.
- ⚠ Do not wash the activated carbon filter.
- ⚠ Water can damage the filter.
- ⚠ Water can decrease filter performance.

Care Instructions

Cleaning the outer body

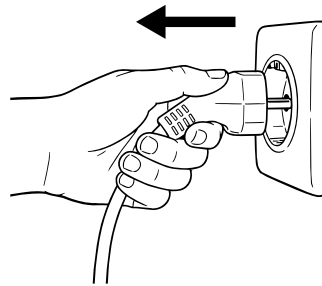

Switch off the purifier.



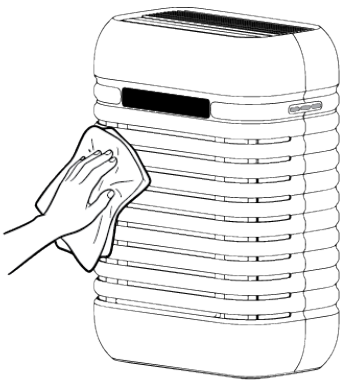

Unplug the purifier.



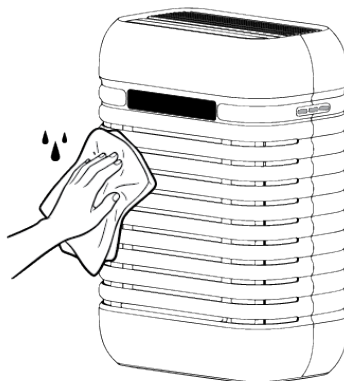

Wipe the outer body with a soft, dry cloth.

Wipe light marks with a damp cloth and dry immediately.



⚠ Moisture Warnings

- Keep water away from vents.
- Keep water away from the display.
- Keep water away from USB-C ports.
- Keep water away from electrical openings.

⊗ Do not use:

- Alcohol
- Solvents
- Wax polish
- Thinner
- Benzene
- Abrasive pads
- Chemical cleaners

⊗ Do not spray these materials into or near the purifier:

- Water
- Perfume
- Room freshener
- Insect repellent
- Cleaning liquid
- Aerosol products

Display Care

- Do not push hard on the OLED display.
- Do not scratch the display.
- Wipe the display with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use alcohol on the display.
- Do not use solvents on the display.
- Do not use cleaning sprays on the display.
- Keep water drops away from the display.
- Keep condensation away from the display.

Storage

- Store the purifier in a cool, dry place.
- Keep the purifier away from direct sunlight.
- Keep the purifier away from moisture.
- Keep the purifier away from chemicals.
- Keep the purifier away from heavy dust.

Safety Instructions

Stop Use Immediately If

Contact JB support if you see or smell:

- Burning smell.
- Smoke.
- Unusual noise.
- Strong vibration.
- Fan blockage.
- Liquid in the purifier.
- Damage to the plug or adapter.
- Damage to the filter cover.
- Damage to the display.
- Damage to the body.
- Damage to the cord.
- Damage after a fall.

What This Purifier Does Not Do

This purifier does not:

- Make oxygen.
- Replace fresh-air ventilation.
- Detect carbon monoxide.
- Detect radon.
- Detect gas leaks.
- Operate as a smoke alarm.
- Operate as a fire-safety device.
- Replace medical treatment.
- Replace medical advice.
- Diagnose disease.
- Prevent disease.
- Treat disease.
- Cure disease.

For best results, decrease indoor pollution sources when possible.

Close doors and windows when outdoor air pollution is high.

⚠ Water, Heat, and Chemicals

Do not use or place the purifier:

- Outdoors.
- In a bathroom.
- Near a shower.
- In a sauna.
- In a laundry area.
- In a wet area.
- Near rain.
- Near dripping water.
- Near splashing water.
- Near condensation.
- Near water vapor.
- Near an open flame.
- Near a stove.
- In an area with hazardous chemicals.
- In a kitchen with heavy oil fumes.
- In an area with industrial fumes.
- In an area with corrosive gas.
- Near flammable gas.
- Near paint thinner.
- Near aerosol sprays.
- Near direct heat.
- Near a radiator.
- Near a heater.
- Near solvents.
- Near fuel.

🐾 Children and Pets

- Do not let children climb on the purifier.
- Do not let children sit on the purifier.
- Do not let children push or pull the purifier.
- Do not let children play with the purifier.
- Do not let children put fingers into vents.
- Do not let children put objects into vents.
- Keep children under supervision near the purifier.
- Do not let pets touch the vents.
- Do not let pets pull the cord.
- Persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental ability must use the purifier only with supervision.

Electrical Safety

- Do not put the cord under carpets, rugs, mats, furniture, or appliances.
- Switch off the purifier before you open the filter compartment.
- Unplug the purifier before you open the filter compartment.
- Hold the plug or adapter when you disconnect the purifier.
- Do not use the purifier if the plug or adapter is damaged.
- Do not use the purifier if the body or display is damaged.
- Do not touch the power connection with wet hands.
- Switch off the purifier before you replace the filter.
- Do not let furniture or appliances pinch the cord.
- Do not use the purifier if the socket is damaged.
- Unplug the purifier before you replace the filter.
- Do not touch the USB-C ports with wet hands.
- Do not use the purifier if the cord is damaged.
- Do not pull the cord to disconnect the purifier.
- Keep the power cord away from hot surfaces.
- Put the cord where people cannot trip on it.
- Switch off the purifier before you move it.
- Do not use overloaded multi-plug boards.
- Do not touch the plug with wet hands.
- Switch off the purifier before cleaning.
- Unplug the purifier before you move it.
- Do not use an external speed controller.
- Do not change internal electrical parts.
- Do not repair internal electrical parts.
- Use only the approved power supply.
- Do not use damaged extension cords.
- Do not use an unapproved smart plug.
- Do not open internal electrical parts.
- Unplug the purifier before cleaning.
- Do not use loose sockets.
- Do not use a dimmer.



Placement and Airflow

- Do not use the purifier unless the filter is installed correctly.
- Do not use the purifier unless all covers are closed correctly.
- Keep furniture away from the air inlet and air outlet.
- Keep curtains away from the air inlet and air outlet.
- Keep bedding away from the air inlet and air outlet.
- Keep paper away from the air inlet and air outlet.
- Put the purifier on a firm, flat, dry surface.
- Put the purifier where it cannot fall easily.
- Do not put heavy objects on the purifier.
- Do not cover the purifier with cloth.
- Do not put objects on the air outlet.
- Use the purifier indoors only.
- Do not stand on the purifier.
- Do not lean on the purifier.
- Keep the purifier upright.
- Do not sit on the purifier.
- Keep the air outlet clear.
- Keep the air inlet clear.



✖ Troubleshooting

Issue	What to do
The purifier does not switch on.	Check the power connection. Check the socket. Check the plug or adapter.
Airflow is weak.	Make sure that filter packing is removed. Make sure that the filter is installed correctly. Make sure that the air inlet and air outlet are clear.
The purifier makes unusual noise.	Put the purifier on a level surface. Make sure that airflow is not blocked. If noise continues, unplug the purifier and contact JB support.
You smell burning or see smoke.	Switch off the purifier. Unplug the purifier immediately. Contact JB support.
The AQI reading changes quickly.	Check for smoke, incense, cooking fumes, dust, open windows, humidity, aerosol sprays, or blocked airflow.
The AQI reading does not look correct.	Move the purifier away from kitchens, bathrooms, water mist, oil fumes, and airflow blocks.
The filter alert stays on after replacement.	Complete the filter reset steps in the digital guide or app.
The app does not connect.	Contact us for assistance.

⚠ If the issue continues, contact JB support. Contact JB before you try to repair or return the purifier.

- Damage caused by operation with filter packing installed.
- Cosmetic wear that does not change product function.
- Damage caused by an incompatible adapter or cord.
- Damage caused by kitchen steam or oil exposure.
- Damage caused by blocked air inlets or outlets.
- Damage caused by an incorrect power supply.
- Damage caused by use outside this guide.
- Damage caused by high-moisture areas.
- Damage caused by unauthorized repair.
- Damage caused by unstable power.
- Damage caused by condensation.
- Damage caused by bathroom use.
- Damage caused by water entry.
